The Long Beach Water Department (LBWD) is submitting this letter for lead user service line inventory and replacement timeline. LBWD does not have service lines with lead or unknown materials, but suspected that there may be galvanized service lines that have short lead "pigtailed" initially installed between the corporation stop and the galvanized service line. LBWD implemented the galvanized service line investigation and replacement program in March 2017. After 3 years of aggressive replacement, there are currently 48 galvanized service lines remaining and the planned replacement timeline is in the enclosed form.
